## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Operate an Automatic Coded Wire Tagging (CWT) Trailer for juvenile salmon marking and tagging operations at tribal and state hatcheries throughout western Washington. This involves scheduling tagging operations, supervising temporary crews, keeping accurate records, quality control, and maintaining specialized equipment.
- Work involves flexible hours and extensive overnight travel in Western Washington.

- Bachelor's degree in Fisheries Science or related field; OR an Associate degree in Fisheries
  and two years pertinent work experience; OR a High School Diploma/equivalent and four
  years pertinent work experience.
