BNGA is a Native developed and led 501(c)(3) nonprofit collaborating with a broad coalition of partners to support conservation and sustainable livelihoods in Native nations in the Northern Great Plains (NGP). BNGA envisions Native nations uniting so the diversity of life in the NGP flourishes for current and future generations. BNGA's mission is to ensure the 15 Native nations in the NGP have the technical and financial resources to plan and act on their vision for their traditional lands and waters, which includes ensuring that:

- Moderating and community managing social media channels.
- Creating copy for social media posts and responses.
- Help to develop creative for cutting edge, world class social media campaigns.
- Periodic qualitative reporting on brands' social media channels.
- Support the messaging and outreach goals of a team of passionate Indigenous leaders.
- Develop and maintain positive working relationships with team members.

Requirements:

- Minimum of two years of experience of professional social media management
- Degree level qualification in Arts & Humanities, Communications, Marketing, Business, or any related field not required but preferred.

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Excellent time management skills.
- Experience with all major social media platforms.
- Problem solving skills and the ability to work independently and with minimal guidance.
- A creative flair both written and visual.
- A drive to learn and grow.
- Experience working with Native nations and Indigenous communities a plus
